Learned counsel for the petitioner relies on the judgment of the Supreme Court dated 15.01.2025, in <i>Rajeev Kalita vs. Union of India and others in Writ Petition (Civil) No.538 of 2023.</i> 6. Learned counsel for the respondents pray

			for and are granted two weeks' time to obtain instructions in the matter. 7. The District Magistrate, Haridwar is directed to get all the toilets in various Courts premises, District Magistrate's Court, Collectorate Office, SSP Office, Tehsil Campus and other Government Offices inspected to ascertain whether the directions issued by the Supreme Court in <i>Rajeev Kalita (supra)</i> are being followed or not. He will also come up with concrete proposals for removing the shortcomings and for ensuring that necessary repairs and maintenance work are undertaken within fixed timelines. 8. The Registrar General will also file his affidavit in respect of the conditions of the toilets in the High Court premises and steps taken so far to bring the same in proper condition. He will also specify that whether all the parameters which have been laid down by the Supreme Court in <i>Rajeev Kalita (supra)</i> are being met or there is any shortcoming and, if so, specifically point out the same. 9.
